

Lake Natoma Kayak Tour

Sunday, October 14, 2018 | 2:00 to 4:30 pm | Nimbus Flat

Join author and retired state park ranger Ken McKowen for this kayak tour exploring Lake Natoma's backwater channels in the Nimbus Flat/Mississippi Bar area.

This is an easy 2.5 hour paddle through the large bike-trail culvert and into the narrow water passageways in what's known as Mississippi Bar. Depending on Lake Natoma's water level, we may have to wade through a small stream leading to the culvert passageway, so be sure to wear appropriate footwear (not flip-flops or tennis shoes that can't get wet).

WHERE & WHEN

We will meet and launch our kayaks (or canoes or water boards) from the launch ramp area at Nimbus Flat, at the West end of Lake Natoma, in the Folsom Lake State Recreation Area, at 2:00 pm. Please arrive at least 15 minutes early to unload and prepare to launch your kayak.



IF YOU WILL NEED TO RENT A KAYAK

Please make arrangements with the CSUS Aquatic Center at (916) 278-2842. Ask for the "student discount rate" (tell them you're with the FOLFAN Kayak Tour). Be sure to get there early enough to rent your kayak and get to our meet-up/launch area by 2:00 pm.

REQUIREMENTS

All participants must be competent at basic recreational kayaking, and have Coast Guard-approved life jackets. Remember to bring water, a snack, bug spray, and sunscreen.
