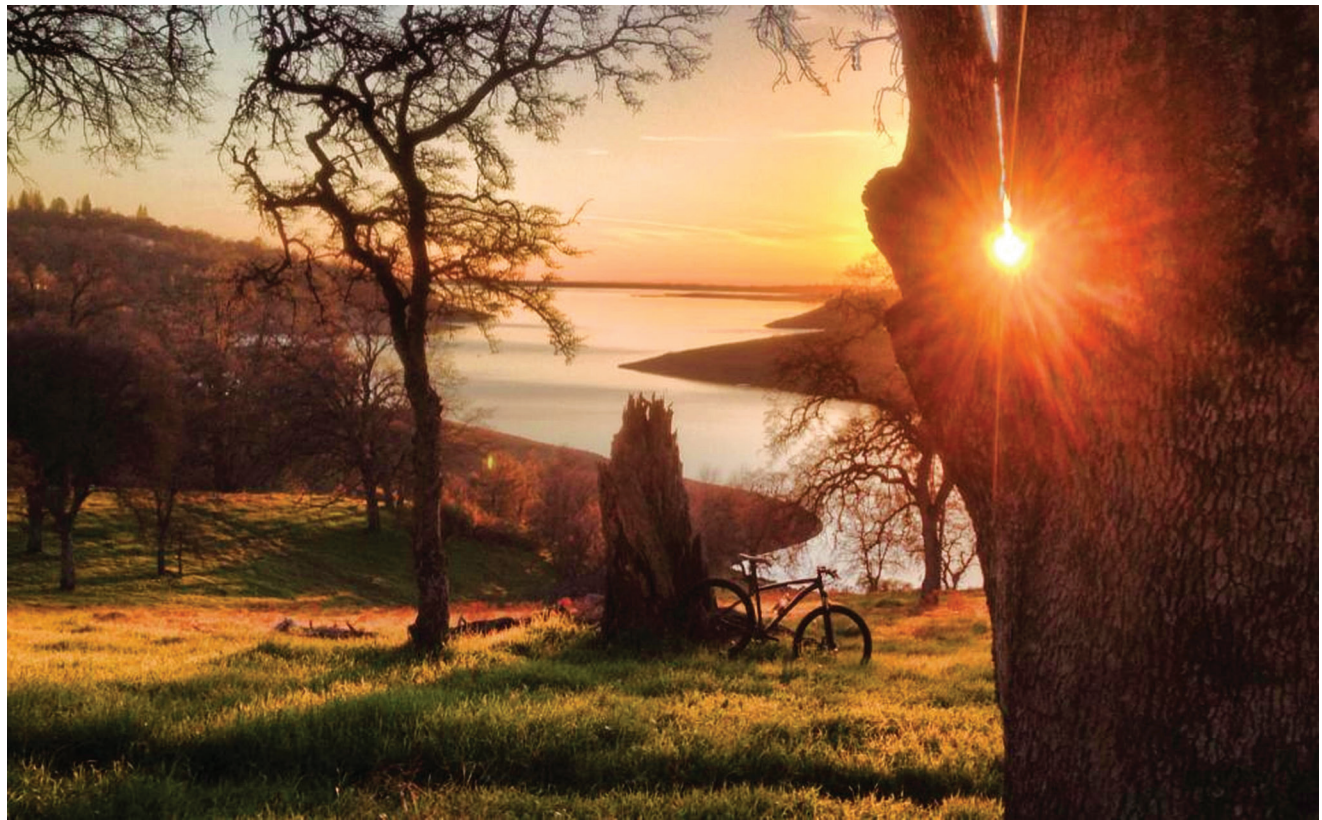


WHAT WE DO

Founded in 2009, **FOLFAN** (Friends of Lakes Folsom and Natoma), originally brought together a few park enthusiasts to support an Adopt-the-Parkway program, forming a non-profit organization to benefit Folsom Lake State Recreation Area. Since then, FOLFAN's programs have expanded to include:

- Kids Don't Float – loaner lifejackets available at popular swimming beaches
- Earth Day Kayak Klean-up – every April
- Great American River Clean-up – every September
- Environmental Education Programs – including summer programs for at-risk youth and hosting the “water conservation” exhibit at the annual Electricity Fair at the Folsom Powerhouse State Historic Park
- Community Outreach – efforts to connect people with the park and with FOLFAN
- Wild Night with FOLFAN – annual event for FOLFAN members and friends, including Photo Contest
- Guided Nature Hikes & Kayak Tours
- Trail Repairs and Signage

FOLSOM LAKE SRA

The Folsom Lake State Recreation Area is one of the most heavily used state parks in California, with more than 2 million visitors annually. The park includes Folsom Lake, Lake Natoma, and 15 miles of the American River Parkway that connect the two lakes.

The SRA has more than 100 miles of trails and 100 miles of shoreline for hiking, biking, swimming, fishing, camping, water sports, and horseback riding.

The park's rolling hills and blue oak woodlands provide a unique habitat for a wide variety of native species.
